Some of us would like to believe that evangelism is just a thing for pastors or missionaries. However, when you examine the scriptures, and Jesus' teachings, it's very clear this is a way of life for every believer. Some are gifted, but all are called.

We can try and dress it up, but evangelism is itself an awkward, and offensive message. We need deliver the bad news that we are separated from a just and holy God and need a way to pay for our sin that has separated us. Christ tells us there is only one way to God and salvation. All other gods or false, and being a 'good person' just won't measure up. But our delivered message is not bad news, but good news because God sent his son as a sacrifice to pay for our sins!
